

According to the directives of the Federal Office of Public Health (FOPH) and the State Secretariat for Economic Affairs (SECO) concerning safety and health at work, and in conformity with the standards of the umbrella associations of ICOM and the Swiss Museums Association (AMS), this protection plan presents the implementation of hygiene and social distancing measures at the Centre d'Art Contemporain Genève. This directive is an individual protection concept that takes into consideration specific characteristics (building, staff, etc.).

Visitor protection

- The total number of visitors is limited to 50 people inside the museum, i.e. one visitor per 25 sqm.
- A distance of 2 m has to be maintained between persons.
- Spacing of furniture in the lobby and opening of the entry doors to minimize handling.
- Reopening of the lobby toilets with disinfectant available and specialized daily cleaning.
- Free admission until the end of the exhibition to avoid transactions.
- Provision of disinfectant product at the entrance to the museum and on all floors.
- Removal of all flyers and documents for free consultation.
- Elevator for individual use only.
- Closure of our Cinema Dynamo.
- Withdrawal from the exhibition of “hands-on” equipment: touch screens, headphones, etc.
- Consultation of the books in our Bookshop on request from the staff and after hand disinfection only.
- Regular cleaning of regularly touched surfaces (handles, knobs, handrails, etc.)

Staff protection

- Plexiglass screen at the reception desk.
- Specialized office cleaning.
- Employees telework whenever possible, offices will be reorganized to comply with the distancing measures in case of work from our offices.
- Staff trained in the use of protective equipment.
- Protection masks and disinfectant products are available for reception and surveillance staff.

Events and public activities

- Cancellation until further notice of all public events: vernissages, late openings, screenings, workshops, group visits, etc.
- Exhibition guides are present in the exhibition. They can interact with a maximum of 4 people, respecting safety distances.
